Make replica from this view.

Trim Color

- ◆ Take one photograph from the view you want your replica made. Make a notation indicating so. A straight on view is usually best, however, an angled view sometimes represents the building best.
- ◆ Make notations indicating if you want anything left out . (For example, power lines, air conditioner units, garbage cans, or any landscaping that hides the building.)
- ◆ Make notations of anything you want “moved” or scaled down. (Trees sometimes look better scaled down as opposed to being left out.)
- ◆ Make notations of anything you want added. (Flowers or leaves if the picture was taken in the wintertime.)



Make notation of anything you want included or excluded or changed in some way.



Lantern color



Make notation of any other details.  
For example, color sample of lights.  
Inclusion or exclusion of decorations, etc.

- ◆ Walk along the buildings taking close-up pictures of the details. The more pictures you include the more accurate we can be.
- ◆ Take a few pictures from each side to show the roof line.

### Helpful Hints

- ◆ The ideal setting for picture taking is an overcast or cloudy day as shadows are more subtle.
- ◆ Use either a 35mm or digital camera.
- ◆ Tape your pictures on 8 1/2 x 11 paper and add your information beside the pictures. (As shown above.)
- ◆ Note the colors of each part of the building. (siding, stone, brick, trim, roof, etc. ) Include color samples. (paint strips from stores
